

- Welcome program for all residents

All rooms are designed for privacy with access to common areas.

Room types and features

- Uniting Amala offers four room types. The approximate size (excluding bathrooms) is:
 - Single room with ensuite 16.4–17.8 m²
 - Larger single room with ensuite 22.5 m²
 - Premium room with ensuite 34.4 m²
 - Shared room with ensuite 34.4m²
- All rooms are bright and airy, in excellent condition and have abundant natural light
- The rooms offer home comforts and include a king single bed, bedside table, furnishings and fittings, personal storage and a washer/dryer
- Each bedroom has an ensuite with handrails, an emergency call system, air conditioning, and a built-in wardrobe
- All rooms are designed for privacy while promoting community living through easy access to common areas.

Common areas

- Uniting Amala's main common and dining rooms are airconditioned and offer a place for residents and their families to gather informally and enjoy use of the large TV, DVD player, seating areas a place to come together for meals
- When privacy is required for family gatherings or quiet discussions, there are garden courtyards or small themed rooms with comfortable seating, tea and coffee making facilities, good lighting and views to the gardens and Brindabella Ranges
- Garden areas provide tranquil outdoor spaces for residents, family and friends to enjoy.

Support services

- Staff strive to create an environment of comfort and familiarity while providing superior care
- Our care support includes local GPs, a podiatrist and a dentist who visit regularly
- Chaplaincy, pastoral care and religious services are available
- Lifestyle programs, bus outings, a library, craft activities and games available to enjoy and promote healthy living
- Residential support services are tailored to you.
