Room types and features

• Uniting Bowden Brae offers four room types. The approximate size (excluding ensuites) are:

Comfort living

- Single room with private ensuite, 16–18m²
- Single room with shared ensuite between two rooms, 16–18m²

Companion living

 Double room with private ensuite, 17–23m²

Secure living

- Dementia specific single room with private ensuite, 16–18m²
- Each bedroom has an ensuite with handrails, an emergency call system and air-conditioning
- All rooms are in superior condition and offer home-like comforts including a bed, bedside table, traditional furnishings and fittings, and personal storage
- Rooms are contemporary, comfortable, clean and ready for any individual to make their home.

Common areas

 The main common room is air-conditioned and offers a place for residents and their families to gather informally and enjoy use of the large modern TV, DVD player, library, seating, and tea and coffee making facilities

- When privacy is required for family gatherings or quiet discussions, there are garden courtyards or small breakout areas with comfortable seating, tea and coffee service and good lighting
- Our secure landscaped grounds offer quiet outdoor spaces to sit and relax with family and friends.

Support services

- Staff strive to create an environment of comfort and familiarity while providing excellent care
- Our care support services include a local GP, podiatrist, and allied health professionals who visit regularly
- Chaplaincy, pastoral care and religious services are available
- Recreational programs, bus outings, a library, craft activities and games are planned by our Leisure and Wellness Coordinator to ensure a variety of social activities and promote healthy living
- Residential support services are tailored to individual needs and preferences.
