Uniting Lilian Wells offers:

Services

- Support for people with dementia and cognitive impairment
- 24-hour professional nursing and personal care
- Cleaning and general laundry services
- Meals and refreshments
- Assistance with daily living activities
- Emotional support, pastoral care and chaplaincy
- Treatments and procedures, rehabilitation support and assistance in obtaining health practitioner services.

All rooms are well maintained and offer home-like comforts including a bed, bedside table, traditional furnishings and fittings and personal storage.

Room types and features

- Uniting Lilian Wells offers single and shared rooms, both with shared bathrooms. The approximate sizes are:
 - Single rooms, 14m²
 - Shared rooms, 17m²
- All rooms are well maintained and offer home-like comforts including a bed, bedside table, traditional furnishings and fittings and personal storage
- Rooms are bright and airy with good natural light and individual air-conditioners for the comfort of residents
- Rooms are grouped in small pods so as to offer privacy promoting community living through easy access to common areas.

Common areas

- Uniting Lilian Wells' main common/lounge room is air-conditioned and offers a place for residents and their families to gather informally and enjoy use of the large modern TV, DVD player and tea and coffee facilities
- When privacy is required for family gatherings or quiet discussions, there is a small breakout room with good lighting and views to the gardens

- The dining room allows residents to enjoy meals with each other and guests in comfortable surroundings.

Support services

- Staff strive to create an environment of comfort and familiarity while providing excellent care
- Specialist services offered for people living with dementia include a dementia clinical nurse and a monthly dementia support group
- Health and allied health support services include audiology, a dietitian, local GPs, optometry, physiotherapy, podiatry and speech therapy
- Chaplaincy and pastoral care and religious services are available
- A massage therapist, a beauty therapist and a hairdresser are also offered for the enjoyment of residents
- Recreational programs and bus outings are organised by our Health & Lifestyle Coordinator to ensure a variety of social activities and to promote healthy living
- Residential support services are tailored to individual needs and preferences.
