

Room types and features

- Uniting Lynvale offers single and shared rooms, some with a shared bathroom. The rooms have an approximate size of:
 - Single rooms, 9–12m²
 - Shared rooms, 14m²
- All rooms are bright and airy and in very good condition, with natural lighting and pleasant views

- The rooms offer home-like comforts including a bed, bedside table, traditional furnishings and fittings and personal storage
- All rooms are designed for privacy while promoting community living through easy access to common areas.

Common areas

- Uniting Lynvale's main common/lounge room is air-conditioned and offers a place for residents and their families to gather informally and enjoy use of the large modern TV, Foxtel, DVD player, library and tea and coffee facilities
- When privacy is required for family gatherings or quiet discussions, there is a small breakout room, with comfortable chairs, tea and coffee facilities and views over the gardens
- Dining rooms are available to enjoy meals with residents and guests in comfortable surroundings
- Uniting Lynvale boasts a large recreation area, patio garden, numerous courtyards including child-friendly areas and a barbeque so residents can enjoy being outdoors.

Support services

- Staff strive to create an environment of comfort and familiarity while providing excellent care
- Our care support includes a local GP, physiotherapist, podiatrist and dentist, all who visit regularly
- Chaplaincy, pastoral care and religious services are available
- Our Activities Director publishes a monthly calendar of social activities to help residents to lead full and active lives
- Residential support services are tailored to individual needs and preferences.
