Services

- Welcome program for all residents
- Support for people with dementia and cognitive impairment
- 24-hour professional nursing and personal care
- Cleaning and general laundry services

- Treatments and procedures, rehabilitation support and assistance in obtaining health practitioner services.

Room types and features

- Uniting Springwood offers a number of room types. The approximate sizes, excluding ensuites, are:
 - Single high care room with shared ensuite, 19m²
 - Double high care room with shared ensuite, 26m²
 - High care dementia support single room with private ensuite, 21m²
 - Hillman House, single room with private ensuite, 22m²
 - Lewin Lodge, single room with private ensuite, 19m²

- Lewin Lodge, large double room with private ensuite, 32m²
- All rooms are bright and airy, in very good condition and have abundant natural light
- The rooms offer home-like comforts including a bed, bedside table, traditional furnishings and fittings and personal storage
- The bathrooms have handrails and an emergency call system
- All rooms are designed for privacy while promoting community living through easy access to common areas.

Common areas

- Uniting Springwood's common room is air-conditioned and offers a place for residents and their families to gather informally and enjoy use of the large modern TV, DVD player, library and seating areas
- When privacy is required for family gatherings or quiet discussions, garden courtyards or a small breakout area with comfortable seating, tea and coffee making facilities, good natural lighting and views to the gardens are available
- Garden areas provide child-friendly outdoor spaces for residents, family and friends to enjoy.

Support services

- Staff strive to create an environment of comfort and familiarity while providing excellent care
- Our care support includes local GPs, a podiatrist and a dentist who visit regularly
- Chaplaincy, pastoral care and religious services are available
- Recreational programs, bus outings, a library, craft activities and games are planned to ensure a variety of social activities and to promote healthy living
- Residential support services are tailored to individual needs and preferences
- Uniting Springwood is proud to offer respite care whenever places are available.
