

Services

- Welcome program for all residents
- Support for people with dementia and cognitive impairment
- 24-hour professional nursing and personal care
- Cleaning and general laundry service
- Meals and refreshments
- Assistance with daily living activities
- Emotional support, pastoral care and chaplaincy
- Treatments and procedures, rehabilitation support and assistance in obtaining health practitioner services.

Room types and features

- Uniting The Marion offers single rooms with private ensuites, some with private balconies or kitchenettes. These rooms have an approximate size of 32m² (excluding ensuite)
- The dementia specific single rooms are an approximate size of 22m² (excluding ensuite) and are located in four secure cottages on the ground floor
- All rooms are bright and airy and in superior condition, with abundant natural lighting, air-conditioning and curtained windows
- Bedrooms feature high quality furnishings and fittings including hospital quality electrical beds and lockable wardrobe cupboards
- Web2TV is available in all rooms.

Common areas

- Uniting The Marion's main common/lounge room is air-conditioned and offers a place for residents and their families to gather informally and enjoy use of the large modern TV, DVD player, library and tea and coffee facilities
- When privacy is required for family gatherings or quiet discussions, there is a dining room and small breakout areas with comfortable chairs, tea and coffee facilities and views over the gardens
- Uniting The Marion features restaurant style dining areas, a library and multiple common rooms with stylish fixtures and finishes
- An electronic security access system and closed circuit television is in place for peace-of-mind
- A built-in programmable dementia monitoring system is also available
- Uniting The Marion's dementia support cottages are safe and secure, and each boasts a common room, lounge and dining area. Residents can also spend time outdoors in the secure landscaped garden or courtyard with BBQ area
- Our staff support residents living in the dementia support cottages to access and enjoy other common areas around Uniting The Marion

- A projector room is available for movie viewing and barbeque areas, terraces and the café which overlooks Lambert Park provide many opportunities for socialising and relaxation
- Landscaped courtyards include children's play equipment for younger visitors, and wireless internet and computers are available to keep residents connected with friends and family
- Secure underground parking area is available for visitors.

Support services

- Staff strive to create an environment of comfort and familiarity while providing excellent care
- Our care support includes a local GP and allied health specialists such as a physiotherapist and podiatrist, who visit regularly
- Uniting The Marion features an onsite chapel, and chaplaincy, pastoral care and religious services are available to all residents
- A salon with day spa facilities and a relaxation program are also available
- Recreational programs, bus outings, in-house entertainment, a gardening program, community centre and an art therapist facilitated studio ensure a variety of social activities and promote healthy living
- Residential support services are tailored to individual needs and preferences.
